Our base will be New Lanark Youth Hostel (a converted row of mill workers' tenements). We shall have time to enjoy the beauty of the Upper Clyde Valley in the Falls of Clyde Wildlife Reserve or / & to explore the World Heritage Site. Accommodation will be in en-suite rooms. Couples will have a room to

themselves. Bed linen is provided but bring your own towels. **Food** – Lindsey and a group of our young people will prepare breakfast and sandwich lunches; we'll take along a pot-luck supper to enjoy together when we arrive on Friday evening.
